

The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 37) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order: To amend the following restrictions in the Borough of Colchester:

- (a) to replace double yellow lines (No Waiting At Any Time) with double red lines (No Stopping At Any Time) on both sides of Whitmore Drive from its junction with Via Urbis Romanae to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Eden Drive; and on both sides of Eden Drive from its junction with Whitmore Drive for 10 metres south.
- (b) to introduce double red lines (No Stopping At Any Time) on both sides of Whitmore Drive entrance to Camulos Academy.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by replacing the following tile number TL995 282 with revision 1.
