

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) (Civil Enforcement Area) And (On-Street Parking Places) (Amendment Number 31) Order 2022

Statement of Reasons

Tysea road – Harlow

The permanent order is required to keep the junction free of parked vehicles where it is considered that any parking is inappropriate. Removing parked vehicles at the junction will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents.

Permanent Orders Section 1(1) of the 1984 Act states that local traffic authorities in England and Wales (outside London)² may make permanent orders for the following purposes:

- To avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- To facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
