

The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 26) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 1 July 2022 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order:

1. To introduce double red lines (No Stopping At Any Time) in the District of Braintree in the following locations: on both sides of Horizon Boulevard; on both sides of Hawking Drive; on both sides of Franklin Gate; on both sides of Rontgen Place; on both sides of Turing Court; on both sides of Rutherford Park; on both sides of Edison Way and on both sides of Whittle End.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by inserting TL730 205; TL730 202; TL735 205; TL735 202; TL735 200 at revision 0.
