The effect of the Order:

- 1. To revoke the resident permit holders only A Mon-Sat 10am 5.30pm on the East kerb near to 1 to 3 Kings Avenue and introduce a Loading Bay in its place.
- 2. To partially revoke the No Waiting at Any Time on the East kerb of Kings Avenue near to 14 to 19 and introduce a resident permit holders only A Mon-Sat 10am 5.30pm.
- 3. To partially revoke the No Waiting at Any Time outside Kings Court, on East kerb of Kings Avenue, Buckhurst Hill and introduce a resident permit holders only A Mon-Sat 10am 5.30pm bay.
- 4. To partially revoke the Controlled zone No waiting Mon Sat 10am 5.30pm outside of Kings Court, Back Lane, Buckhurst Hill and to introduce a shared use Resident/Business permit holders only A Mon Sat 10am 5.30pm and create 3 bays to accommodate the entrance/exit of Kings Court, Back Lane, Buckhurst Hill.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by replacing tile numbers TQ415 937 revision 2 replaced by TQ415 937 revision 3.

Date of operation: The Order will come into operation on Monday 4th August 2025.

Statement of Reasons

The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment 47) Order 2025.

Kings Avenue and Back Lane, Buckhurst Hill

Back Lane – To accommodate new entrance/exit to Kings Court, Back Lane, Buckhurst Hill it is necessary to revise the permit holders only bays outside of Kings Court.

The second bay (Entering Back Lane from Kings Avenue) will be extended toward Kings Avenue. The bay will be split into two to allow a new access point into Kings Court.

Kings Avenue – The resident permit holders bay nearest to the junction with Queens road will be replaced by a vehicle Loading bay to allow service to the business premises at the Queens road/Kings Avenue junction.

The resident permit holders bays on Kings Avenue to the south of Back Lane will be extended.

An additional Resident permit holders bay will be introduced outside of Kings Court near to the junction of Langfords.

The extension and addition of bays will accommodate vehicles displaced by the introduction of the loading bay.


